

Second update of the 2012 Helicopter Monitoring Program

Floatables:

The New York/New Jersey Harbor Complex was monitored for floatables five times from June 9 to June 15. The harbor was clear of significant floatable debris on all five days. The floatable flight was not conducted on June 9 due to mechanical problems with the helicopter.

On June 13, an oily sheen, approximately 2500 feet long and 50 feet wide, was reported southeast of Perth Amboy, in Raritan Bay. Oily sheens are reported to the US Coast Guard.
