

Third update of the 2009 Helicopter Monitoring Program

The New York/New Jersey Harbor Complex was monitored for floatables three times from June 6 - 12. The Harbor was clear of significant floatables on June 6 and 8. Floatable flights were not conducted on June 9, 10, and 11 due to rain and fog.

On June 12, a small slick, approximately 200 yards long by 10 yards wide, was reported in the Upper Harbor.

The floatable debris consisted of large wood, paper and plastics and was reported to Army Corps of Engineers. The Army Corps of Engineers conducted clean-ups as necessary.
