

8th Update of the Helicopter Monitoring Program

Floatables:

The New York/New Jersey Harbor Complex was monitored for floatables four times from July 19 - 25. The helicopter was down for poor weather on July 24 and for maintenance on July 25. The Harbor was clear of significant floatables on July 19, 22 and 23.

On July 21, a slick, approximately 2,000 feet long by 5 feet wide, was reported in the Lower Harbor.

The floatable debris slick consisted of large wood and plastics and was reported to Army Corps of Engineers. The Army Corps of Engineers conducted clean-ups as necessary.
